### GOD IS SPIRIT

**John 4:23-24** "But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him.

**24** "God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth

**Exodus 19:4** 'You have seen what I did to the Egyptians, and how I bore you on eagles' wings and brought you to Myself.

**Ruth 2:12** "The LORD repay your work, and a full reward be given you by the LORD God of Israel, under whose wings you have come for refuge."

**Psalms 17:8** Keep me as the apple of Your eye; Hide me under the shadow of Your wings,

**Psalms 36:7** How precious is Your lovingkindness, O God! Therefore the children of men put their trust under the shadow of Your wings.

**Psalms 57:1** Be merciful to me, O God, be merciful to me! For my soul trusts in You; And in the shadow of Your wings I will make my refuge, Until these calamities have passed by.

**Psalms 61:4** I will abide in Your tabernacle forever; I will trust in the shelter of Your wings. Selah

**Psalms 63:7** Because You have been my help, Therefore in the shadow of Your wings I will rejoice.

**Psalms 91:4** He shall cover you with His feathers, And under His wings you shall take refuge; His truth shall be your shield and buckler.

**John 4:24** "God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth

**Acts 17:24-25** "God, who made the world and everything in it, since He is Lord of heaven and earth, does not dwell in temples made with hands.

**25** "Nor is He worshiped with men's hands, as though He needed anything, since He gives to all life, breath, and all things.

**Hebrews 11:27** By faith he forsook Egypt, not fearing the wrath of the king; for he endured as seeing Him who is invisible.

**1 Timothy 1:17** Now to the King eternal, immortal, invisible, to God who alone is wise, be honor and glory forever and ever. Amen.

**1 Timothy 6:15-16** which He will manifest in His own time, He who is the blessed and only Potentate, the King of kings and Lord of lords,  
**16** who alone has immortality, dwelling in unapproachable light, whom no man has seen or can see, to whom be honor and everlasting power. Amen.

**Deuteronomy 4:11-12** "Then you came near and stood at the foot of the mountain, and the mountain burned with fire to the midst of heaven, with darkness, cloud, and thick darkness.

**12** "And the LORD spoke to you out of the midst of the fire. You heard the sound of the words, but saw no form; you only heard a voice.

**Deuteronomy 4:15-16** "Take careful heed to yourselves, for you saw no form when the LORD spoke to you at Horeb out of the midst of the fire,

**16** "lest you act corruptly and make for yourselves a carved image in the form of any figure: the likeness of male or female,

**John 6:46** "Not that anyone has seen the Father, except He who is from God; He has seen the Father.

**John 1:18** No one has seen God at any time. The only begotten Son, who is in the bosom of the Father, He has declared Him.

**Colossians 1:15** He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation.

**John 14:9** Jesus said to him, "Have I been with you so long, and yet you have not known Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; so how can you say, 'Show us the Father'?"

## **GOD IS PERSONAL**

### **GOD IS AWARE OF HIS OWN EXISTENCE:**

**Exodus 3:14** And God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM." And He said, "Thus you shall say to the children of Israel, 'I AM has sent me to you.'"

**Isaiah 45:21** Tell and bring forth your case; Yes, let them take counsel together. Who has declared this from ancient time? Who has told it from that time? Have not I, the LORD? And there is no other God besides Me, A just God and a Savior; There is none besides Me.

**Isaiah 40:25** "To whom then will you liken Me, Or to whom shall I be equal?" says the Holy One.

## **GOD POSSESSES AN INTELLECT:**

**Psalm 92:5-6** O LORD, how great are Your works! Your thoughts are very deep.  
**6** A senseless man does not know, Nor does a fool understand this.

**Romans 11:33-36** Oh, the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are His judgments and His ways past finding out!

**34** "For who has known the mind of the LORD? Or who has become His counselor?"

**35** "Or who has first given to Him And it shall be repaid to him?"

**36** For of Him and through Him and to Him are all things, to whom be glory forever. Amen.

**Psalm 94:11** The LORD knows the thoughts of man, That they are futile.

**1 Corinthians 3:20** and again, "The LORD knows the thoughts of the wise, that they are futile."

**Isaiah 55:8-9** "For My thoughts are not your thoughts, Nor are your ways My ways," says the LORD.

**9** "For as the heavens are higher than the earth, So are My ways higher than your ways, And My thoughts than your thoughts.

**1 Corinthians 1:20** Where is the wise? Where is the scribe? Where is the disputer of this age? Has not God made foolish the wisdom of this world?

**1 Corinthians 1:25** Because the foolishness of God is wiser than men, and the weakness of God is stronger than men.

**John 1:18** No one has seen God at any time. The only begotten Son, who is in the bosom of the Father, He has declared Him.

**1 Corinthians 2:11-12** For what man knows the things of a man except the spirit of the man which is in him? Even so no one knows the things of God except the Spirit of God.

**12** Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might know the things that have been freely given to us by God.

**Psalms 119:97-100** Oh, how I love Your law! It is my meditation all the day.

**98** You, through Your commandments, make me wiser than my enemies; For they are ever with me.

**99** I have more understanding than all my teachers, For Your testimonies are my meditation.

**100** I understand more than the ancients, Because I keep Your precepts.

**Deuteronomy 29:29** "The secret things belong to the LORD our God, but those things which are revealed belong to us and to our children forever, that we may do all the words of this law.

## GOD POSSESSES A WILL

**Proverbs 19:21** There are many plans in a man's heart, Nevertheless the LORD'S counsel-that will stand.

**Isaiah 14:27** For the LORD of hosts has purposed, And who will annul it? His hand is stretched out, And who will turn it back?"

**Isaiah 46:9-10** Remember the former things of old, For I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is none like Me,

**10** Declaring the end from the beginning, And from ancient times things that are not yet done, Saying, 'My counsel shall stand, And I will do all My pleasure,'

**Daniel 4:34-35** And at the end of the time I, Nebuchadnezzar, lifted my eyes to heaven, and my understanding returned to me; and I blessed the Most High and praised and honored Him who lives forever: For His dominion is an everlasting dominion, And His kingdom is from generation to generation.

**35** All the inhabitants of the earth are reputed as nothing; He does according to His will in the army of heaven And among the inhabitants of the earth. No one can restrain His hand Or say to Him, "What have You done?"

**Ephesians 1:11** In Him also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestined according to the purpose of Him who works all things according to the counsel of His will,

**Titus 1:2** in hope of eternal life which God, who cannot lie, promised before time began,

**2 Timothy 2:13** If we are faithless, He remains faithful; He cannot deny Himself.

**James 1:13** Let no one say when he is tempted, "I am tempted by God"; for God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does He Himself tempt anyone.

## GOD IS RELATIONAL

**Genesis 3:8-10** And they heard the sound of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God among the trees of the garden. **9** Then the LORD God called to Adam and said to him, "Where are you?"

**10** So he said, "I heard Your voice in the garden, and I was afraid because I was naked; and I hid myself."

**Genesis 3:23-24** therefore the LORD God sent him out of the garden of Eden to till the ground from which he was taken.

**24** So He drove out the man; and He placed cherubim at the east of the garden of Eden, and a flaming sword which turned every way, to guard the way to the tree of life.

**Isaiah 59:1-2** Behold, the LORD'S hand is not shortened, That it cannot save; Nor His ear heavy, That it cannot hear.

**2** But your iniquities have separated you from your God; And your sins have hidden His face from you, So that He will not hear.

**Genesis 3:8-9** And they heard the sound of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God among the trees of the garden.  
**9** Then the LORD God called to Adam and said to him, "Where are you?"

**Acts 17:26-27** And He has made from one blood every nation of men to dwell on all the face of the earth, and has determined their preappointed times and the boundaries of their dwellings,  
**27** "so that they should seek the Lord, in the hope that they might grope for Him and find Him, though He is not far from each one of us;

**Luke 19:10** "for the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost."

**Romans 5:8-10** But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

**9** Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him.  
**10** For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.

**Colossians 1:19-22** For it pleased the Father that in Him all the fullness should dwell,  
**20** and by Him to reconcile all things to Himself, by Him, whether things on earth or things in heaven, having made peace through the blood of His cross.

**21** And you, who once were alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now He has reconciled  
**22** in the body of His flesh through death, to present you holy, and blameless, and above reproach in His sight—

**John 17:3** "And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.

**2 Corinthians 6:16-18** And what agreement has the temple of God with idols? For you are the temple of the living God. As God has said: "I will dwell in them And walk among them. I will be their God, And they shall be My people."

**17** Therefore "Come out from among them And be separate, says the Lord. Do not touch what is unclean, And I will receive you."

**18** "I will be a Father to you, And you shall be My sons and daughters, Says the LORD Almighty."

**2 Timothy 2:19** Nevertheless the solid foundation of God stands, having this seal: "The Lord knows those who are His," and, "Let everyone who names the name of Christ depart from iniquity."

**2 Corinthians 5:18-20** Now all things are of God, who has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation,

**19** that is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them, and has committed to us the word of reconciliation

**20** Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: we implore you on Christ's behalf, be reconciled to God.
