### GOD IS OMNIPOTENT

**Jeremiah 32:17** 'Ah, Lord GOD! Behold, You have made the heavens and the earth by Your great power and outstretched arm. There is nothing too hard for You.

**Jeremiah 23:23-24** "Am I a God near at hand," says the LORD, "And not a God afar off?

**24** Can anyone hide himself in secret places, So I shall not see him?" says the LORD; "Do I not fill heaven and earth?" says the LORD.

**Genesis 17:1** When Abram was ninety-nine years old, the LORD appeared to Abram and said to him, "I am Almighty God; walk before Me and be blameless.

**Revelation 4:8** The four living creatures, each having six wings, were full of eyes around and within. And they do not rest day or night, saying: "Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, Who was and is and is to come!"

**Revelation 19:6** And I heard, as it were, the voice of a great multitude, as the sound of many waters and as the sound of mighty thunderings, saying, "Alleluia! For the Lord God Omnipotent reigns!

**Psalms 24:8** Who is this King of glory? The LORD strong and mighty, The LORD mighty in battle.

**Psalms 31:2** Bow down Your ear to me, Deliver me speedily; Be my rock of refuge, A fortress of defense to save me.

**Psalms 61:3** For You have been a shelter for me, A strong tower from the enemy.

**Isaiah 9:6** For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

**Isaiah 10:21** The remnant will return, the remnant of Jacob, To the Mighty God.

**Luke 1:49** For He who is mighty has done great things for me, And holy is His name.

**2** “I know that you can do everything, And that no purpose of Yours can be withheld from You.

**Psalms 115:3** But our God is in heaven; He does whatever He pleases.

**Psalms 135:5-6** For I know that the LORD is great, And our Lord is above all gods.

**6** Whatever the LORD pleases He does, In heaven and in earth, In the seas and in all deep places.

**Isaiah 14:24** The LORD of hosts has sworn, saying, "Surely, as I have thought, so it shall come to pass, And as I have purposed, so it shall stand:

**Isaiah 14:27** For the LORD of hosts has purposed, And who will annul it? His hand is stretched out, And who will turn it back?"

**Daniel 4:35** All the inhabitants of the earth are reputed as nothing; He does according to His will in the army of heaven And among the inhabitants of the earth. No one can restrain His hand Or say to Him, "What have You done?"

**Ephesians 1:11** In Him also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestined according to the purpose of Him who works all things according to the counsel of His will,

**Psalms 115:3-8** But our God is in heaven; He does whatever He pleases. **4** Their idols are silver and gold, The work of men's hands. **5** They have mouths, but they do not speak; Eyes they have, but they do not see; **6** They have ears, but they do not hear; Noses they have, but they do not smell; **7** They have hands, but they do not handle; Feet they have, but they do not walk; Nor do they mutter through their throat. **8** Those who make them are like them; So is everyone who trusts in them.

**Psalm 115:9-11** O Israel, trust in the LORD; He is their help and their shield.  
**10** O house of Aaron, trust in the LORD; He is their help and their shield.  
**11** You who fear the LORD, trust in the LORD; He is their help and their shield.

**Joshua 23:14** "Behold, this day I am going the way of all the earth. And you know in all your hearts and in all your souls that not one thing has failed of all the good things which the LORD your God spoke concerning you. All have come to pass for you; not one word of them has failed.

**Psalm 121:4-5** Behold, He who keeps Israel Shall neither slumber nor sleep.  
**5** The LORD is your keeper; The LORD is your shade at your right hand.

**Romans 8:31** What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us?

**Philippians 1:6** being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ;

**2 Corinthians 3:4-5** And we have such trust through Christ toward God.  
**5** Not that we are sufficient of ourselves to think of anything as being from ourselves, but our sufficiency is from God,

**Philippians 4:13** I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.

**Romans 4:19-21** And not being weak in faith, he did not consider his own body, already dead (since he was about a hundred years old), and the deadness of Sarah's womb.  
**20** He did not waver at the promise of God through unbelief, but was strengthened in faith, giving glory to God,  
**21** and being fully convinced that what He had promised He was also able to perform.

## **GOD IS OMNIPRESENT**

**1 King 8:27** "But will God indeed dwell on the earth? Behold, heaven and the heaven of heavens cannot contain You. How much less this temple which I have built!

**8** If I ascend into heaven, You are there; If I make my bed in hell, behold, You are there.

**9** If I take the wings of the morning, And dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea,

**10** Even there Your hand shall lead me, And Your right hand shall hold me.

**Jeremiah 23:23-24** "Am I a God near at hand," says the LORD, "And not a God afar off?

**24** Can anyone hide himself in secret places, So I shall not see him?" says the LORD; "Do I not fill heaven and earth?" says the LORD.

**Acts 17:24-28** "God, who made the world and everything in it, since He is Lord of heaven and earth, does not dwell in temples made with hands.

**25** "Nor is He worshiped with men's hands, as though He needed anything, since He gives to all life, breath, and all things.

**26** "And He has made from one blood every nation of men to dwell on all the face of the earth, and has determined their preappointed times and the boundaries of their dwellings,

**27** "so that they should seek the Lord, in the hope that they might grope for Him and find Him, though He is not far from each one of us;

**28** "for in Him we live and move and have our being, as also some of your own poets have said, 'For we are also His offspring.'

**Deuteronomy 4:7** "For what great nation is there that has God so near to it, as the LORD our God is to us, for whatever reason we may call upon Him?

**Psalm 46:1** God is our refuge and strength, A very present help in trouble.

**Psalm 145:18** The LORD is near to all who call upon Him, To all who call upon Him in truth.

**Isaiah 43:1-2** But now, thus says the LORD, who created you, O Jacob, And He who formed you, O Israel: "Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by your name; You are Mine.

**2** When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; And through the rivers, they shall not overflow you. When you walk through the fire, you shall not be burned, Nor shall the flame scorch you.

**Matthew 18:20** "For where two or three are gathered together in My name, I am there in the midst of them."

**Matthew 28:20** "teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen.

## **GOD IS OMNISCIENT**

**1 Samuel 2:3** "Talk no more so very proudly; Let no arrogance come from your mouth, For the LORD is the God of knowledge; And by Him actions are weighed.

**Daniel 2:20-22** Daniel answered and said: "Blessed be the name of God forever and ever, For wisdom and might are His.

**21** And He changes the times and the seasons; He removes kings and raises up kings; He gives wisdom to the wise And knowledge to those who have understanding.

**22** He reveals deep and secret things; He knows what is in the darkness, And light dwells with Him.

**Job 37:16** Do you know how the clouds are balanced, Those wondrous works of Him who is perfect in knowledge?

**Psalms 147:4-5** He counts the number of the stars; He calls them all by name.

**5** Great is our Lord, and mighty in power; His understanding is infinite.

**Isaiah 40:28** Have you not known? Have you not heard? The everlasting God, the LORD, The Creator of the ends of the earth, Neither faints nor is weary. His understanding is unsearchable.

**Isaiah 44:6-8** "Thus says the LORD, the King of Israel, And his Redeemer, the LORD of hosts: 'I am the First and I am the Last; Besides Me there is no God.

**7** And who can proclaim as I do? Then let him declare it and set it in order for Me, Since I appointed the ancient people. And the things that are coming and shall come, Let them show these to them.

**8** Do not fear, nor be afraid; Have I not told you from that time, and declared it? You are My witnesses. Is there a God besides Me? Indeed there is no other Rock; I know not one.'"

**Isaiah 46:9-10** Remember the former things of old, For I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is none like Me,

**10** Declaring the end from the beginning, And from ancient times things that are not yet done, Saying, 'My counsel shall stand, And I will do all My pleasure,'

**Psalm 139:1-4** O LORD, You have searched me and known me.

**2** You know my sitting down and my rising up; You understand my thought afar off.

**3** You comprehend my path and my lying down, And are acquainted with all my ways.

**4** For there is not a word on my tongue, But behold, O LORD, You know it altogether.

**Psalm 139:11-12** If I say, "Surely the darkness shall fall on me," Even the night shall be light about me;

**12** Indeed, the darkness shall not hide from You, But the night shines as the day; The darkness and the light are both alike to You.

**1 Kings 8:39** "then hear in heaven Your dwelling place, and forgive, and act, and give to everyone according to all his ways, whose heart You know (for You alone know the hearts of all the sons of men),

**Psalm 7:9** Oh, let the wickedness of the wicked come to an end, But establish the just; For the righteous God tests the hearts and minds.

**Psalm 94:11** The LORD knows the thoughts of man, That they are futile.

**Romans 2:16** in the day when God will judge the secrets of men by Jesus Christ, according to my gospel.

**2 Chronicles 16:9** "For the eyes of the LORD run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to show Himself strong on behalf of those whose heart is loyal to Him. In this you have done foolishly; therefore from now on you shall have wars."

**Matthew 6:7-8** "And when you pray, do not use vain repetitions as the heathen do. For they think that they will be heard for their many words.

**8** "Therefore do not be like them. For your Father knows the things you have need of before you ask Him.

**Matthew 6:31-32** "Therefore do not worry, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?'

**32** "For after all these things the Gentiles seek. For your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things.

**Matthew 10:29-31** "Are not two sparrows sold for a copper coin? And not one of them falls to the ground apart from your Father's will.

**30** "But the very hairs of your head are all numbered.

**31** "Do not fear therefore; you are of more value than many sparrows.

**Job 34:21-23** "For His eyes are on the ways of man, And He sees all his steps.

**22** There is no darkness nor shadow of death Where the workers of iniquity may hide themselves.

**23** For He need not further consider a man, That he should go before God in judgment.

**Psalms 33:13-15** The LORD looks from heaven; He sees all the sons of men.

**14** From the place of His dwelling He looks On all the inhabitants of the earth;

**15** He fashions their hearts individually; He considers all their works.

**Proverbs 5:21** For the ways of man are before the eyes of the LORD, And He ponders all his paths.

**Proverbs 15:3** The eyes of the LORD are in every place, Keeping watch on the evil and the good.

**Jeremiah 17:10** I, the LORD, search the heart, I test the mind, Even to give every man according to his ways, According to the fruit of his doings.

**Jeremiah 32:19** 'You are great in counsel and mighty in work, for your eyes are open to all the ways of the sons of men, to give everyone according to his ways and according to the fruit of his doings.

**Hebrews 4:13** And there is no creature hidden from His sight, but all things are naked and open to the eyes of Him to whom we must give account.

## Does God ever Changes His mind or purposes?

**Genesis 6:6-7** And the LORD was sorry that He had made man on the earth, and He was grieved in His heart.

7 So the LORD said, "I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth, both man and beast, creeping thing and birds of the air, for I am sorry that I have made them."

**Exodus 32:14** So the LORD relented from the harm which He said He would do to His people.

**1 Samuel 15:11** "I greatly regret that I have set up Saul as king, for he has turned back from following Me, and has not performed My commandments." And it grieved Samuel, and he cried out to the LORD all night.

**2 Samuel 24:16** And when the angel stretched out His hand over Jerusalem to destroy it, the LORD relented from the destruction, and said to the angel who was destroying the people, "It is enough; now restrain your

**Jonah 3:10** Then God saw their works, that they turned from their evil way; and God relented from the disaster that He had said He would bring upon them, and He did not do it.

**Joel 2:13-14** So rend your heart, and not your garments; Return to the LORD your God, For He is gracious and merciful, Slow to anger, and of great kindness; And He relents from doing harm.

14 Who knows if He will turn and relent, And leave a blessing behind Him — A grain offering and a drink offering For the LORD your God?

**Culver**, 'His treatment of us was and is always the same a holy response to our good or evil actions and intent. Divine predictions Jonah made of Nineveh's destruction were conditional upon the city's response to the treats (of resistance or repentance).'

**Packer**, 'God never changes in His being and purposes.'

- ✓ Life of God never changes: always eternal.
- ✓ God's Character never changes: nothing can alter His character.
- ✓ God's Truth never changes: His trust stands and abides forever.
- ✓ God's Way's never changes: His dealings with us are the same as in Bible times.
