LESSON #6 "GOD IS HOLY"

THE MEANING OF HOLY

Isaiah 6:1-3 In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, high and lifted up, and the train of His robe filled the temple. **2** Above it stood seraphim; each one had six wings: with two he covered his face, with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew. **3** And one cried to another and said: "Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts; The whole earth is full of His glory!"

GOD IS TRANSCENDENT ABOVE HIS CREATION

THE HOLINESS OF GOD

EXODUS 3:14 And God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM." And He said, "Thus you shall say to the children of Israel, 'I AM has sent me to you.'"

Psalms 111:9 He has sent redemption to His people; He has commanded His covenant forever: Holy and awesome is His name.

Isaiah 57:15 For thus says the High and Lofty One Who inhabits eternity, whose name is Holy: "I dwell in the high and holy place, With him who has a contrite and humble spirit, To revive the spirit of the humble, And to revive the heart of the contrite ones."

Isaiah 6:3 And one cried to another and said: "Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts; The whole earth is full of His glory!"

Revelation 4:8 The four living creatures, each having six wings, were full of eyes around and within. And they do not rest day or night, saying: "Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, Who was and is and is to come!"

Exodus 15:11 "Who is like You, O LORD, among the gods? Who is like You, glorious in holiness, Fearful in praises, doing wonders?"

1 Samuel 2:2 "No one is holy like the LORD, For there is none besides You, Nor is there any rock like our God."

Job 15:15 If God puts no trust in His saints, And the heavens are not pure in His sight,

Isaiah 40:25 "To whom then will you liken Me, Or to whom shall I be equal?" says the Holy One.

Psalms 5:4 For You are not a God who takes pleasure in wickedness, Nor shall evil dwell with You.

Job 34:10 "Therefore listen to me, you men of understanding: Far be it from God to do wickedness, And from the Almighty to commit iniquity.

Isaiah 59:1-2 Behold, the LORD'S hand is not shortened, That it cannot save; Nor His ear heavy, That it cannot hear. **2** But your iniquities have separated you from your God; And your sins have hidden His face from you, So that He will not hear.

Habakkuk 1:13a ...you are of purer eyes than to behold evil, And cannot look on wickedness. Why do You look on those who deal treacherously, And hold Your tongue when the wicked devours A person more righteous than he?

James 1:13 Let no one say when he is tempted, "I am tempted by God"; for God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does He Himself tempt anyone.

James 1:17 Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and comes down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow of turning.

1 John 1:5 This is the message which we have heard from Him and declare to you, that God is light and in Him is no darkness at all.

Deuteronomy 25:16 "For all who do such things, all who behave unrighteously, are an abomination to the LORD your God.

Psalms 5:4-5 For You are not a God who takes pleasure in wickedness, Nor shall evil dwell with You. **5** The boastful shall not stand in Your sight; You hate all workers of iniquity.

Proverbs 15:8-9 The sacrifice of the wicked is an abomination to the LORD, But the prayer of the upright is His delight. **9** The way of the wicked is an abomination to the LORD, But He loves him who follows righteousness.

OUR RESPONSE TO GOD'S HOLINESS

Proverbs 9:10 "The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom, And the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding.

Hebrews 12:14 Pursue peace with all people, and holiness, without which no one will see the Lord:

Hebrews 12:5-11 And you have forgotten the exhortation which speaks to you as to sons: "My son, do not despise the chastening of the LORD, Nor be discouraged when you are rebuked by Him; **6** For whom the LORD loves He chastens, And scourges every son whom He receives." **7** If you endure chastening, God deals with you as with sons; for what son is there whom a father does not chasten? **8** But if you are without chastening, of which all have become partakers, then you are illegitimate and not sons. **9** Furthermore, we have had human fathers who corrected us, and we paid them respect. Shall we not much more readily be in subjection to the Father of spirits and live? **10** For they indeed for a few days chastened us as seemed best to them, but He for our profit, that we may be partakers of His holiness. **11** Now no chastening seems to be joyful for the present, but painful; nevertheless, afterward it yields the peaceable fruit of righteousness to those who have been trained by it.

Psalms 96:9 Oh, worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness! Tremble before Him, all the earth.

Isaiah 6:2-3 Above it stood seraphim; each one had six wings: with two he covered his face, with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew. **3** And one cried to another and said: "Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts; The whole earth is full of His glory!"

Isaiah 8:13 The LORD of hosts, Him you shall hallow; Let Him be your fear, And let Him be your dread.

Habakkuk 2:20 But the LORD is in His holy temple. Let all the earth keep silence before Him."

Ecclesiastes 5:1-2 Walk prudently when you go to the house of God; and draw near to hear rather than to give the sacrifice of fools, for they do not know that they do evil. **2** Do not be rash with your mouth, And let not your heart utter anything hastily before God. For God is in heaven, and you on earth; Therefore let your words be few.

Psalms 30:4 Sing praise to the LORD, You saints of His, And give thanks at the remembrance of His holy name.

Psalm 97:12 Rejoice in the LORD, you righteous, And give thanks at the remembrance of His holy name.

Psalm 99:3 Let them praise Your great and awesome name-He is holy.

Psalm 99:5 Exalt the LORD our God, And worship at His footstool-He is holy.

Psalm 99:9 Exalt the LORD our God, And worship at His holy hill; For the LORD our God is holy.

Isaiah 12:6 Cry out and shout, O inhabitant of Zion, For great is the Holy One of Israel in your midst!"

Revelation 15:4 Who shall not fear You, O Lord, and glorify Your name? For You alone are holy. For all nations shall come and worship before You, For Your judgments have been manifested."

Leviticus 20:26 'And you shall be holy to Me, for I the LORD am holy, and have separated you from the peoples, that you should be Mine.

Leviticus 22:31-33 "Therefore you shall keep My commandments, and perform them: I am the LORD. **32** You shall not profane My holy name, but I will be hallowed among the children of Israel. I am the LORD who sanctifies you, **33** "who brought you out of the land of Egypt, to be your God: I am the LORD."

2 Corinthians 6:16-7:1 And what agreement has the temple of God with idols? For you are the temple of the living God. As God has said: "I will dwell in them And walk among them. I will be their God, And they shall be My people." 17 Therefore "Come out from among them And be separate, says the Lord. Do not touch what is unclean, And I will receive you." 18 "I will be a Father to you, And you shall be My sons and daughters, Says the LORD Almighty."

2 Corinthians 7:1 Therefore, having these promises, beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God.

Ephesians 4:22-24 that you put off, concerning your former conduct, the old man which grows corrupt according to the deceitful lusts, **23** and be renewed in the spirit of your mind, **24** and that you put on the new man which was created according to God, in true righteousness and holiness.

2 Timothy 2:19-21 Nevertheless the solid foundation of God stands, having this seal: "The Lord knows those who are His," and, "Let everyone who names the name of Christ depart from iniquity." **20** But in a great house there are not only vessels of gold and silver, but also of wood and clay, some for honor and some for dishonor. **21** Therefore if anyone cleanses himself from the latter, he will be a vessel for honor, sanctified and useful for the Master, prepared for every good work.

1 Peter 1:14-17 as obedient children, not conforming yourselves to the former lusts, as in your ignorance; **15** but as He who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct, **16** because it is written, "Be holy, for I am holy." **17** And if you call on the Father, who without partiality judges according to each one's work, conduct yourselves throughout the time of your stay here in fear;

Psalm 15:1-5 LORD, who may abide in Your tabernacle? Who may dwell in Your holy hill? **2** He who walks uprightly, And works righteousness, And speaks the truth in his heart; **3** He who does not backbite with his tongue, Nor does evil to his neighbor, Nor does he take up a reproach against his friend; **4** In whose eyes a vile person is despised, But he honors those who fear the LORD; He who swears to his own hurt and does not change; **5** He who does not put out his money at usury, Nor does he take a bribe against the innocent. He who does these things shall never be moved.

Psalm 24:3-6 Who may ascend into the hill of the LORD? Or who may stand in His holy place? **4** He who has clean hands and a pure heart, Who has not lifted up his soul to an idol, Nor sworn deceitfully. **5** He shall receive blessing from the LORD, And righteousness from the God of his salvation. **6** This is Jacob, the generation of those who seek Him, Who seek Your face.
