

# Truth About Man

## Lesson 11, God's Judgment of Death

**Genesis 2:17** "but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall surely die."

**Romans 6:23** For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

**James 2:26** For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also.

**Ecclesiastes 12:7** Then the dust will return to the earth as it was, And the spirit will return to God who gave it.

**Psalms 146:4** His spirit departs, he returns to his earth; In that very day his plans perish.

**Genesis 49:33** And when Jacob had finished commanding his sons, he drew his feet up into the bed and breathed his last, and was gathered to his people.

**Job 34:20** In a moment they die, in the middle of the night; The people are shaken and pass away; The mighty are taken away without a hand.

**Genesis 3:19** In the sweat of your face you shall eat bread Till you return to the ground, For out of it you were taken; For dust you are, And to dust you shall return.

**Psalms 104:29** You hide Your face, they are troubled; You take away their breath, they die and return to their dust.

**Job 24:24** They are exalted for a little while, Then they are gone. They are brought low; They are taken out of the way like all others; They dry out like the heads of grain.

**2 Timothy 4:6** For I am already being poured out as a drink offering, and the time of my departure is at hand.

**2 Peter 1:15** Moreover I will be careful to ensure that you always have a reminder of these things after my decease.

**Genesis 2:17** "but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall surely die."

**Ezekiel 18:4** Behold, all souls are Mine; The soul of the father As well as the soul of the son is Mine; The soul who sins shall die.

**Ezekiel 18:20** The soul who sins shall die. The son shall not bear the guilt of the father, nor the father bear the guilt of the son. The righteousness of the righteous shall be upon himself, and the wickedness of the wicked shall be upon himself.

**Romans 6:23** For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

**James 1:15** Then, when desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, brings forth death.

**Isaiah 64:6** But we are all like an unclean thing, And all our righteousnesses are like filthy rags; We all fade as a leaf, And our iniquities, like the wind, Have taken us away.

**Psalms 90:3-10** You turn man to destruction, And say, "Return, O children of men."  
4 For a thousand years in Your sight Are like yesterday when it is past, And like a watch in the night.  
5 You carry them away like a flood; They are like a sleep. In the morning they are like grass which grows up:  
6 In the morning it flourishes and grows up; In the evening it is cut down and withers.  
7 For we have been consumed by Your anger, And by Your wrath we are terrified.  
8 You have set our iniquities before You, Our secret sins in the light of Your countenance.  
9 For all our days have passed away in Your wrath; We finish our years like a sigh.  
10 The days of our lives are seventy years; And if by reason of strength they are eighty years, Yet their boast is only labor and sorrow; For it is soon cut off, and we fly away.

**Daniel 5:23** And you have lifted yourself up against the Lord of heaven. They have brought the vessels of His house before you, and you and your lords, your wives and your concubines, have drunk wine from them. And you have praised the gods of silver and gold, bronze and iron, wood and stone, which do not see or hear or know; and the God who holds your breath in His hand and owns all your ways, you have not glorified.

**Deuteronomy 32:39** Now see that I, even I, am He, And there is no God besides Me; I kill and I make alive; I wound and I heal; Nor is there any who can deliver from My hand.

**1 Samuel 2:6** The LORD kills and makes alive; He brings down to the grave and brings up.

**Job 14:5** Since his days are determined, The number of his months is with You; You have appointed his limits, so that he cannot pass.

**Ecclesiastes 3:2** A time to be born, And a time to die; A time to plant, And a time to pluck what is planted;

**Hebrews 9:27** And as it is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment,

**Luke 12:20** But God said to him, 'Fool! This night your soul will be required of you; then whose will those things be which you have provided?'

**Joshua 23:14** Behold, this day I am going the way of all the earth. And you know in all your hearts and in all your souls that not one thing has failed of all the good things which the LORD your God spoke concerning you. All have come to pass for you; not one word of them has failed.

**1 Kings 2:1-2** Now the days of David drew near that he should die, and he charged Solomon his son, saying:

2 "I go the way of all the earth; be strong, therefore, and prove yourself a man.

**Hebrews 9:27** And as it is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment,

**Job 21:22-26** Can anyone teach God knowledge, Since He judges those on high?

23 One dies in his full strength, Being wholly at ease and secure;

24 His pails are full of milk, And the marrow of his bones is moist.

25 Another man dies in the bitterness of his soul, Never having eaten with pleasure.

26 They lie down alike in the dust, And worms cover them.

**Ecclesiastes 2:16** For there is no more remembrance of the wise than of the fool forever, Since all that now is will be forgotten in the days to come. And how does a wise man die? As the fool!

**Ecclesiastes 1:2** "Vanity of vanities," says the Preacher; "Vanity of vanities, all is vanity."

**Job 14:1-2** "Man who is born of woman Is of few days and full of trouble.

2 He comes forth like a flower and fades away; He flees like a shadow and does not continue.

**Psalms 39:4-6** LORD, make me to know my end, And what is the measure of my days, That I may know how frail I am.

5 Indeed, You have made my days as handbreadths, And my age is as nothing before You; Certainly every man at his best state is but vapor. Selah

6 Surely every man walks about like a shadow; Surely they busy themselves in vain; He heaps up riches, And does not know who will gather them.

**Psalms 78:39** For He remembered that they were but flesh, A breath that passes away and does not come again.

**Psalms 103:14-16** For He knows our frame; He remembers that we are dust.

15 As for man, his days are like grass; As a flower of the field, so he flourishes.

16 For the wind passes over it, and it is gone, And its place remembers it no more.

**Psalms 144:3-4** LORD, what is man, that You take knowledge of him? Or the son of man, that You are mindful of him?

4 Man is like a breath; His days are like a passing shadow.

**James 4:14** whereas you do not know what will happen tomorrow. For what is your life? It is even a vapor that appears for a little time and then vanishes away.

**Job 4:18-21** If He puts no trust in His servants, If He charges His angels with error,

19 How much more those who dwell in houses of clay, Whose foundation is in the dust, Who are crushed before a moth?

20 They are broken in pieces from morning till evening; They perish forever, with no one regarding.

21 Does not their own excellence go away? They die, even without wisdom.'

**Job 9:25-26** Now my days are swifter than a runner; They flee away, they see no good.

26 They pass by like swift ships, Like an eagle swooping on its prey.

**Psalm 49:10-14** For he sees wise men die; Likewise the fool and the senseless person perish, And leave their wealth to others.

11 Their inner thought is that their houses will last forever, Their dwelling places to all generations; They call their lands after their own names.

12 Nevertheless man, though in honor, does not remain; He is like the beasts that perish.

13 This is the way of those who are foolish, And of their posterity who approve their sayings. Selah

14 Like sheep they are laid in the grave; Death shall feed on them; The upright shall have dominion over them in the morning; And their beauty shall be consumed in the grave, far from their dwelling.

**Ecclesiastes 3:19-20** For what happens to the sons of men also happens to animals; one thing befalls them: as one dies, so dies the other. Surely, they all have one breath; man has no advantage over animals, for all is vanity.

20 All go to one place: all are from the dust, and all return to dust.

**Ecclesiastes 5:15-17** As he came from his mother's womb, naked shall he return, To go as he came; And he shall take nothing from his labor Which he may carry away in his hand.

16 And this also is a severe evil—Just exactly as he came, so shall he go. And what profit has he who has labored for the wind?

17 All his days he also eats in darkness, And he has much sorrow and sickness and anger.

**1 Timothy 6:7** For we brought nothing into this world, and it is certain we can carry nothing out.

**Job 14:7-12** For there is hope for a tree, If it is cut down, that it will sprout again, And that its tender shoots will not cease.

8 Though its root may grow old in the earth, And its stump may die in the ground,

9 Yet at the scent of water it will bud And bring forth branches like a plant.

10 But man dies and is laid away; Indeed he breathes his last And where is he?

11 As water disappears from the sea, And a river becomes parched and dries up,

12 So man lies down and does not rise. Till the heavens are no more, They will not awake Nor be roused from their sleep.

**Psalm 49:7-9** None of them can by any means redeem his brother, Nor give to God a ransom for him—

8 For the redemption of their souls is costly, And it shall cease forever—

9 That he should continue to live eternally, And not see the Pit.

**Psalm 89:48** What man can live and not see death? Can he deliver his life from the power of the grave? Selah

**Ecclesiastes 8:8** No one has power over the spirit to retain the spirit, And no one has power in the day of death. There is no release from that war, And wickedness will not deliver those who are given to it.

**Isaiah 40:6-8** The voice said, "Cry out!" And he said, "What shall I cry?" "All flesh is grass, And all its loveliness is like the flower of the field.

7 The grass withers, the flower fades, Because the breath of the LORD blows upon it; Surely the people are grass.

8 The grass withers, the flower fades, But the word of our God stands forever."

**Ecclesiastes 12:1** Remember now your Creator in the days of your youth, Before the difficult days come, And the years draw near when you say, "I have no pleasure in them":
